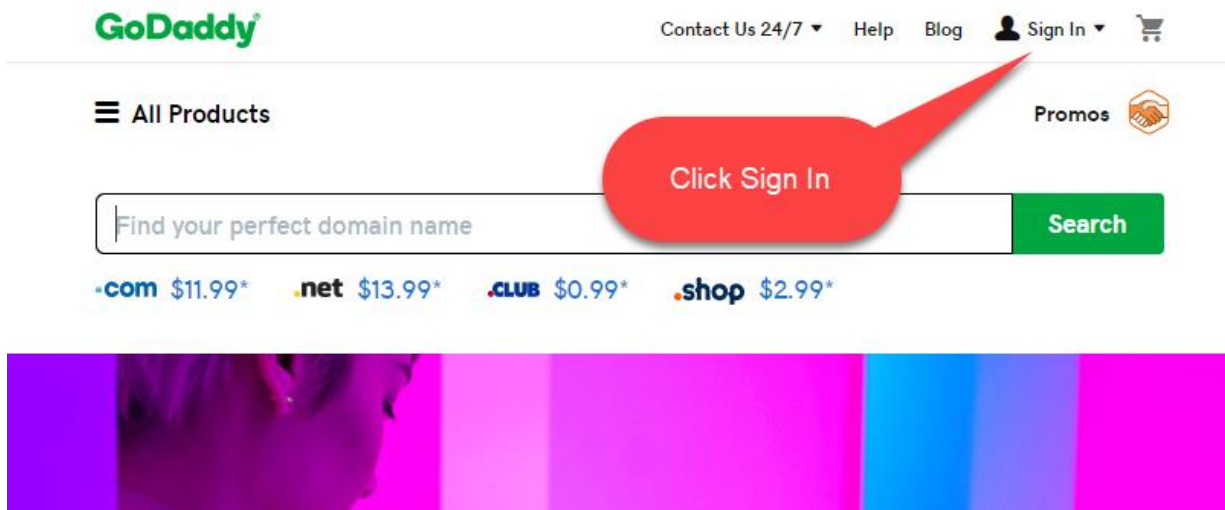
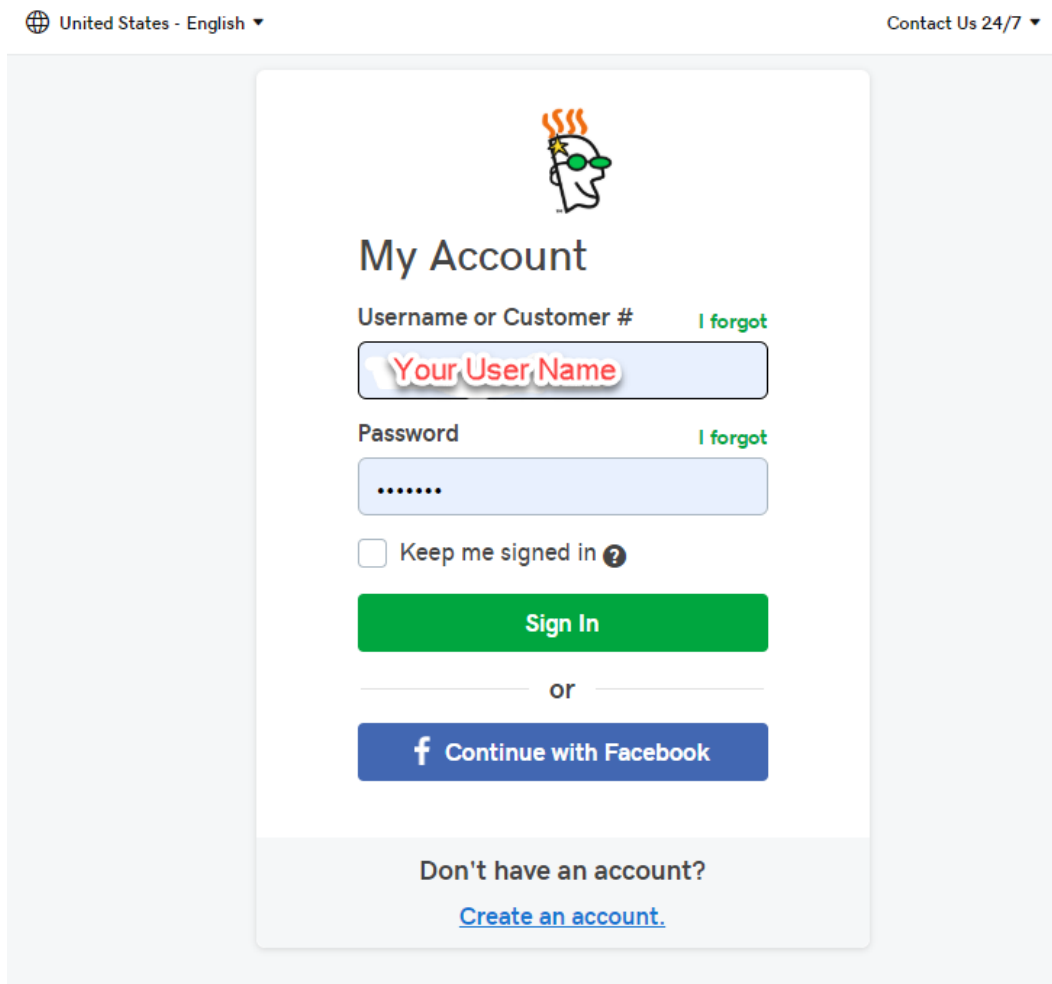


GoDaddy.com DNS Change Instructions

Login to your GoDaddy.com account at www.GoDaddy.com.

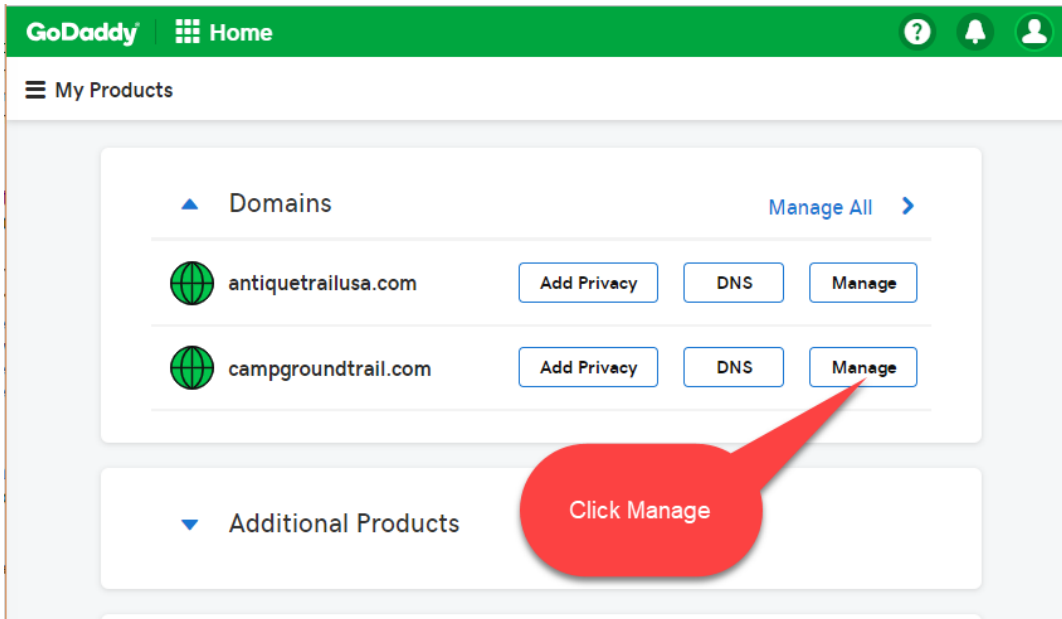


Enter your username and password:



Next, you should see these options for all your domains.

Click **Manage** beside the domain you want to change:



Scroll down to the “Additional Settings” section and select “Manage DNS”

Additional Settings

Automatically renew your domain with your card on file so you never lose your domain.

Auto renew: On [Cancel domain on 2/5/20](#)

Locking prevents unauthorized changes, including transfer to another registrar.
